

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Electrical outlets are provided for all residents parking spaces. Timers must be used when automobile block heaters are being used to minimize hydro costs. Failure to comply will result in electrical outlets being put on timers. In car heaters are not allowed (Item 21 Rules & Regulations revised June 2009, Architectural Policies and Guidelines).

There is no need for cars to have their block heaters plugged in for greater than three hours. The cost of electricity is increasing all the time.

SNOW PLOWING

Snow plowing of parking areas will begin when snowfall has accumulated to 5 cm. If necessary an early morning pass will be done to open up roadways and the job will be finished later in the day. If the town plow has not been by already our contractor will return again to check access to the parking lot. To properly clean the parking lot it is essential that **all** vehicles be removed. Please ensure your vehicle(s) are removed by 9:00 a.m. In the case of a very heavy snowfall the cleanup may continue over a couple of days. Snow removal signs have been purchased and will be placed in the lot to indicate that vehicles should be parked elsewhere. If you are going to be away for a period of time please make arrangements to leave a key with someone so that the vehicle can be moved if necessary.

When a light snowfall is called for the walks will be done when the snow has stopped. When 15 cm or more fall it may be necessary to do the walks more than once. Salt and sanding will be done automatically when freezing rain occurs. Any other time the contractor must be notified by someone who is authorized to do this. San is available in storage boxes around the complex. This may be used on common area walks if required in between visits from the contractor.

STOOP & SCOOP

Another friendly reminder that all of you with dogs, please remember to stoop and scoop as soon as your' pet is finished. We have had complaints about feces in the common areas not being cleaned up right away.

SIGN UP FOR WINTER PARKING BAN NOTIFICATION

You can now get a notification sent to your inbox when the winter parking ban is in effect in Carleton Place. Anytime Environmental Canada forecasts a snowfall of 7cm or more an overnight parking ban will be in effect. When this ban is in effect parking is prohibited on all town streets between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. to allow for snow clearing operations. Go to www.carletonplace.ca to sign up.
